The Harrison County Sheriff's Office has been getting reports from citizens that a group of phone scammers are targeting people in our area using a common phone scam that impersonates a police officer who claims they have a warrant/fines on them or their loved ones and then demands immediate payment to avoid being arrested.

They will falsely claim to be a real sheriff deputy, often using the rank of Sergeant, and then demand payment usually by cash, gift card, crypto, payment app, or wire transfer.

- Real law enforcement officers will never call you to threaten arrest.
- Real law enforcement officers will never demand that you pay fines immediately over the phone.
- Only scammers will demand immediate payment by cash, gift card, crypto, payment app, or wire transfer.
